

Test Of Proficiency-Huayu

Scholarship Application Procedures for Outstanding Overseas Participants

To encourage and reward outstanding overseas participants who have taken the “Test Of Proficiency-Huayu”, the Ministry of Education, ROC (Taiwan) has established for outstanding overseas participants the “Scholarship for Outstanding Overseas Test Participants of the Test Of Proficiency-Huayu” and authorizes the “Steering Committee for the Test Of Proficiency-Huayu” (hereinafter referred to as SC-TOP) to be in charge of matters relevant to this Scholarship.

1. The amount of the Scholarship:
Total NTD25,000 for each recipient.
2. The Quota of recipients:
Based on each level of the “Test Of Proficiency-Huayu”, three participants with the highest scores at each level, for a total of twelve participants, will receive a Scholarship.
3. Term period:
Within 1 year, beginning from October 1st, 2010, recipients shall choose their study timeframe in Taiwan. They may not retain a Scholarship if they fail to study in Taiwan within the indicated study term period, and this shall be deemed as a waiver of their qualification to receive the Scholarship.
4. Application period:
Applications shall be assessed from August 1st to 31th, 2010.
5. Qualification for Scholarship application:
A applicant shall conform to the following qualifications:
 - (1) Hold degrees of high school or above;
 - (2) Is not a ROC citizen or hold ROC nationality status;
 - (3) Is not an overseas ROC student or hold the status as an overseas ROC student;
 - (4) Must not be a native speaker of Huayu;
 - (5) Has a valid “Certificate of Test Of Proficiency-Huayu” with outstanding scores.

6. Application documents:

Applicants shall submit the following documents to the ROC (Taiwan) embassy in their home countries. A personal application shall not be accessed.

- (1) Scholarship application form
- (2) Copies of passport or other identification
- (3) Copies of the highest academic degree certificate received
- (4) Copies of score and certificate of the “Test Of Proficiency-Huayu” certificate

7. Evaluation and Scholarship approval:

After a preliminary review which will be conducted by the R.O.C (Taiwan) embassies, application documents of each three candidates at every test level shall be submitted to the SCTOP before September 15th, 2010. SCTOP shall submit a recipient name list to R.O.C (Taiwan) embassies and provide copies of this name list to the Ministry of Education, the Bureau of Consular Affairs under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the National Immigration Agency under the Ministry of Internal Affairs, and the university-affiliated education centers of Huayu (Chinese) as a second language (hereinafter referred to as HSL centers) in R.O.C (Taiwan), before September 30th, 2010.

8. Application for school enrollment:

R.O.C (Taiwan) embassies shall notify recipients and recipients shall voluntarily apply for school enrollment within the term period at the affiliated HSL centers of universities which has been approved by the Ministry of Education to enroll as overseas students.

9. Appropriation of the Scholarship:

Recipients shall report to SCTOP after they have arrived in the R.O.C (Taiwan) and have registered at the HSL centers. The application for the Scholarship shall be submitted along with copies of the registration payment receipt and student identification, and SCTOP shall appropriate the total amount of the Scholarship. The recipients shall be responsible for the cost of their airplane ticket(s) to the R.O.C (Taiwan), living expenses, and tuition fees.

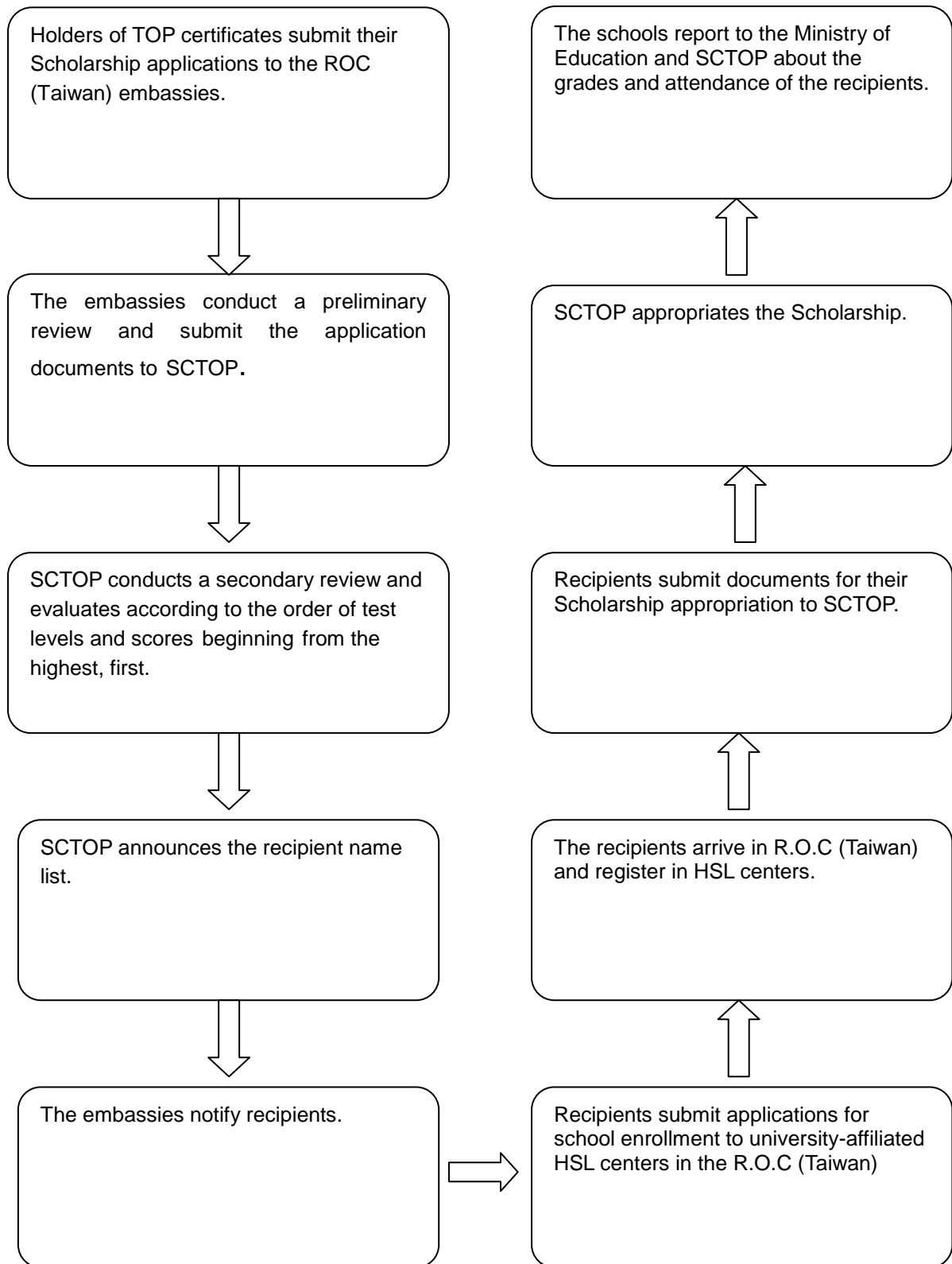
